What is a Vial of Life?

Some of you may have noticed the red stickers around the community with the term “Vial of Life” on them, but wondered what it was. The Vial of Life program is a FREE to use form that has your personal medical information on it in case of an emergency. It can be completed in 3 easy steps:

1. Fill out the Vial of Life Form (located on the ledge by the mailboxes)
2. Place the completed form, along with copies of any health care directives, in a baggie. Place one of the red Vial Of Life stickers on the baggie and hang it on your refrigerator
3. Place the other red, Vial of Life sticker outside your apartment door. This will let first responders know you have this form completed and where to find it.

Should you need to be brought in to the hospital, the contents of the baggie will go with you. This is an optional program. If you have any questions, please see Tonya
